Extract of Minutes of the Management Committee and Hash Council Meeting held at the Pavilion Terrace, RSC Sports Annexe, Bukit Kiara on Wednesday, 9th September, 1998.

7. Hash Archivable materials Ex Tim Hughes, Hash Exhibition for Interhash '98 and the Hash House Project.

It was approve that :-

- The 'Hash Heritage Trust' be formed as a non-profit entity.
- To transfer the Hash Archivable materials Ex Tim Hughes to the trust.
- The following senior hash members would serve as the Board of Trustees:
 - Mr. Fu Chee Cheng (Chairman)
 - Mr. Bill Panton
- Mr. Chris Boyd and Mr. Opera Cheong volunteered their services and were co-opted to the sub-committee.
- The mission of the Trust would be to take care of the heritage aspects of hashing in general for the interest of the hashers worldwide and in particular to:
 - Manage and develop the hash archives.
 - Hold the hash exhibition for Interhash '98
 - Play a key role to rebuild The Hash House.
- The Trust shall be self-financing and pose no financial burden on The Hash House Harriers, Kuala Lumpur.

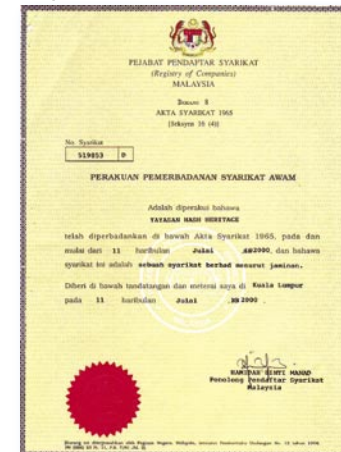

1998 was a momentous year for the preservation of the hash heritage.

Firstly, Tim Hughes' legacy comprising 23 boxes of heritage materials was passed on from Bangkok HHH to The Hash House Harriers. Both chapters quickly realized that the preservation of the hash heritage, not to mention the rebuilding of the Hash House, was beyond the scope of their mission as hashing clubs. The search for a suitable and independent vehicle begun. On 11 September 1998, the Management Committee and Hash Council of The Hash House Harriers found the way forward. (See 'Declaration')

Secondly, KL98 Interhash Committee in supporting the above, pledged to donate part of their surplus as a seed fund for the formation of a Foundation. Encouraged by the foregoing, members of the hash fraternity present at the KL98 Interhash were invited to join as members of the proposed Foundation. An international composition of 23 hashers responded to the invitation. They are now the Founder Trustees of the Foundation that was incorporated on 11 July, 2000.
